PSAT Score Release - December 7th

Next week, the College Board will release the results from this fall's PSAT 8/9, PSAT 10, and PSAT/NMSQT. Students can access their results through their online College Board student account, all 10th and 11th graders received classroom guidance on how to set up and access their accounts this past fall. 9th graders will be looking at their PSAT results and learning about resources to help their growth on the tests early in the 3rd quarter.
