Strategic Plan Process Overview This will kick into full gear in the New Year with community meetings, district staff engagement meetings, as well as a SWOT analysis. More to come. The fall third grade state reading test results arrived (digitally) December 4. We are busy analyzing the data. While not a true "apples-to-apples" comparison, this year's fall results are higher than last year's fall results. Note: Last year there was three weeks less instruction due to starting after Labor Day. Thus, time-on-task regarding instruction may just have an impact! December 14 begins end-of-course testing with American Government at the high school. Last year for this same test, 100% of students scored proficient or higher. No pressure. Several curriculum reviews and potential adoptions have been well underway for some time this fall. Particular courses in ELA, science and social studies are under review at the high school as well as K-5 math at the elementary school. More to come.
